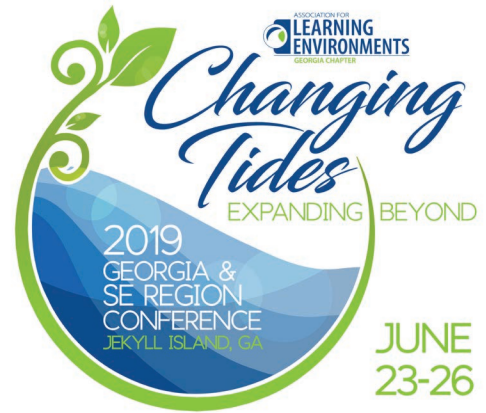


2019 CLASSROOM OF THE FUTURE CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS



The Georgia Chapter and Southeast Region of the Association for Learning Environments Annual Summer Conference to be held at Jekyll Island, Georgia, on June 23-26, 2019 is seeking submittals from vendors and suppliers to display an innovative and high-tech classroom of the future as a tool for exploration and discovery during our conference.

INQUIRY

What is the classroom of the future going to look like?
Will the technology of today and changing learning styles change classrooms?
Has anything really changed inside the four walls of the classroom?

The growth of technology and the breadth of work being done to incorporate 21st Century Learning concepts into our schools have raised more questions than answers. The desire for the display is to create an interest in how new ideas and new technologies might be used in classroom environments. Each room will be open during the conference for attendees to explore and experience the products and concepts available to their districts.

Please note - our intention is to display ideas, technologies and products available for use in outfitting classrooms of the future, not to provide a separate marketing location for the vendors and/or companies. Each company will be allowed to place discreet signage identifying the manufacturer and/or provider of the material in the space and must have an exhibit booth location within the main exhibitor space.

WHAT IS REQUIRED?

Room Information –

There are two to four (2-4) spaces available for use and final location for the submittal will be determined by the selection committee consisting of members of the Board of Directors for the Georgia Chapter and Southeast Region of the Association for Learning Environments. The spaces designated for outfitting are in a prime, centrally located in the exhibit hall. All spaces will be uniform in size 15' deep by 30' long with excessive ceiling heights. Additional specific details, if required, will be provided to the selected teams so detailed planning can be done prior to the conference. Basic internet access, power and overhead lighting are available in the space.

Assembling the Team –

The Georgia Chapter and Southeast Region of the Association for Learning Environments is requesting that vendors and suppliers team together to provide a fully outfitted space to the greatest extent possible – including technology, furnishings and furniture. Teams may include an architect and/or educational planner to assist in the layout. As a team, your members are

responsible for the delivery, set up and breakdown of the room at the time designated for the conference. Specific delivery access must be coordinated with the Jekyll Island Convention Center staff. Contact names will be provided to the selected teams.

Submittal Package –

- Letter of Intent: Provide a letter identifying the primary firm(s) that will participate in your display and the over intent of the display.
- SECTION 1: Submit a brief overview of the members of your group and their respective product(s) to be used in the display.
- SECTION 2: Provide a description, picture, rendering or other visual that allows the selection committee to understand what the room will look like and how it will be set up. Include a list of all furniture, furnishings and equipment.
- SECTION 3: Provide a written summary of the innovative strategies and ideas to be on display in the space.
- SECTION 4: Provide contact information for the Primary Team Contact. *(NOTE – This is the person who will receive correspondence, notifications, etc. and will be the person responsible for the coordination of the installation's assembly and breakdown.)*

SUBMITTALS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY IN AN EASILY READ FORMAT SUCH AS A PDF FILE TO THE FOLLOWING E-MAIL ADDRESS – **info@ga4le.org**.

Proposals are due on or before 5:00 pm on March 28, 2019.

SELECTION COMMITTEE –

- The Selection Committee will review and evaluate all submittals received by the due date and time. Selection will be based on creativity and innovative approaches to the classroom of the future.
- The winning teams will be notified by email and/or phone call.
- Notification will include the room assignment and specific details about the space.

MISCELLANEOUS REQUIREMENTS –

- All team members must be the Georgia Chapter of the Association for Learning Environments Annual Sponsors and must have an exhibit booth space in the exhibit area. (As a reminder, no vendor or supplier will be allowed to use the space as a marketing venue outside signage placed in the space)
- The classroom of the future will be open during the exhibitor hours.
- All costs for the shipment of furniture and equipment to and from the conference will be the responsibility of the team.
- Any additional costs for power and data to the classroom will be the responsibility of the team. (This will be coordinated with the Georgia Chapter of the Association for Learning Environments and Jekyll Island Convention Center)
- The existing lighting in the room may not be removed or modified.
